Nat was born in Coventry on 12th August 1938 to Scottish parents who had moved from Scotland due to his father's employment. (*Nat will acknowledge that he was born in England but is proud that he was made in Scotland*).

Nat and his mother returned to Scotland when his father was mobilised due to the outbreak of war. They went to live with his grandmother in Kirkcaldy in Fife.

Nat started primary school in Kirkcaldy, before moving up to Kirkcaldy High School, where he was followed by the Ex Prime Minister Gordon Brown (*Nat is keen to point out that he holds no responsibility*).

Nat was most industrious while at school, he rose early and delivered fresh bread rolls to the homes of coal miners between 4 and 5 am. At 5.00am he then started a paper round before school.

Leaving school he worked for William Alexandra the largest bus/coach company in Scotland as a parcel delivery boy for 10/- a week. Staying with the transport theme he moved on to British Railways in the goods yard at Kirkcaldy where he developed his affection for steam engines. He became a footplate worker.

His attempt to join the forces was frustrated as his work was classified as reserved.

When he was 21 Nat was initiated into Lodge St.Clair of Dysart 520 which had many family connections beginning a long and distinguished career in Freemasonry.

In 1961 he moved to Glasgow, where he joined 74th Glasgow Company of the Boy's Brigade. This turned out to be a good move as he met Margaret, who was working with the Lifebuoys. Margaret and Nat were married in 1962.

The railways were declining and Nat needed to look elsewhere for employment. Fortunately for us, he came to Lancashire and joined the Lancashire Constabulary where he soon resumed his connection with transport by becoming a traffic Officer in Widnes.

In 1970 Nat joined Kingsway Lodge and began a new career in Freemasonry. All of those who know Nat are aware of the substantial input he has made to Widnes Freemasonry.

Tony was born in Sale (Manchester) on the 8th July 1934 The family returned to Widnes in 1936 where Tony's father ran his own building firm.

Tony started school at Warrington Road Primary School in 1939 and moved to Fairfield in 1945.

During the war Tony's father had worked for the government and in 1945 was sent out to the Far East to help supervise rebuilding as the Japanese Army surrendered.
